- 2. At least five (5) years' experience as a full-time paid civilian/military firefighter. Twenty-four (24) months continuous military service a traditional guardsman/reservist in Fire Protection is considered equivalent to one (1) year full-time paid civilian/military experience.
- 3. Possess a valid state driver's license and if authorized to operate a government vehicle and have the ability to obtain and maintain a U.S. Government Motor Vehicle Operator's ID card. PROOF OF DRIVER'S LICENSE MUST BE SUBMITTED WITH APPLICATION.
- 4. Must meet <u>ANG Level II Fire Protection Certificates (AF132-2001, ANGSUP 1, and Mar 2020)</u>: Require the following DoD Certifications: Firefighter I and II, Airport Firefighter, Haz-Mat Awareness/Ops, Driver Operator Pumper/ARFF/Water Tender, Fire Instructor I and Fire Officer I, Fire Inspector I, Emergency Medical Responder. PROOF OF CERTIFICATIONS MUST BE SUBMITTED WITH APPLICATION.
- 5. Must be able to obtain a favorable National Agency Check (NAC).
- 6. Ability to read and interpret regulations, instructions, and National Fire Protection Standards.
- 7. Must Possess medical license as an NREMR at minimum.
- 8. Ability to use sound judgment in an atmosphere of high excitement while wearing a self-contained breathing apparatus.
- 9. Physical dexterity sufficient to climb heights and maneuver in closely confined spaces.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES: (Not all inclusive, will be fully explained during interview)

- 1. As directed by the senior firefighters, drives assigned vehicle to the scene of any emergency and operates equipment assigned.
- 2. Operated the pumping system, maintaining the pressure of the water/foam or chemical at the desired level.
- 3. Must sustain a working knowledge of construction features of various types of aircraft, both civilian and military, to include helicopter and transient aircraft utilizing the base facilities.
- 4. Provide instruction, both in classroom and in practical demonstration in structural and crash rescue techniques, first aid, fire prevention, conducting inspection, and in the use of a variety of modern structural and crash firefighting equipment.
- 5. As assigned, inspect such equipment as fire hydrants, fire extinguishers, etc. As scheduled, inspect all assigned equipment.
- 6. Ad required, perform all normal housekeeping duties in the maintenance of equipment and station.
- 7. Incumbent will accomplish duties as related to the fire service and directed by the senior firefighter.
