



## MISSISSIPPI NATIONAL GUARD COMMAND SERGEANT MAJOR STANLEY T. WILLIAMS 184TH SUSTAINMENT COMMAND, MISSISSIPPI

Command Sgt. Maj. Stanley T. Williams, Command Sergeant Major of the 184th Sustainment Command (Expeditionary), Mississippi Army National Guard, is a native of Ellisville, Mississippi. He began his military career with the Mississippi Army National Guard after completing Basic Training at Fort Dix, New Jersey in November 1988 and Advanced Individual Training at Fort Eustis, Virginia, graduating the Traffic Management Coordinator course in January 1989.
